What is Ayantsu? ...  
It means "a charming and quaint way" in Miyako dialect.  
From a walk course focusing on cultural properties, we will introduce you to the power spot tour.  
You can walk to "Hirara north course" from the harbor.

It is also called "Tsukasaya" as Miyako's best-sacred place as an Utaki officially authorized by the former Ryukyu government.



It was established in 1925 enshrining Nakasone Tuyumya, the leader of Miyakojima. Locals visit here to worship at a wedding ceremony and new year celebration.



It is the tomb of Mr. Nakasone  
Tuyumya, the leader of Miyakojima  
in the late 15th century. It is made of a  
huge stone called "Miyaka" and this  
type of an eclectic tomb in the lateral  
hole cemetery can be seen on  
mainland Okinawa.



This 143-meter-high head tax was imposed only to Miyako and Yeyama by the Ryukyu Dynasty which was poor due to the invasion of the Satsuma clan. Every man and woman had to pay millet and Jofu fabric respectively when they grew taller than this stone at the age of 15.



This well was only used by a part of the senior officials of the Shuri administration of the Ryukyu Kingdom. Youzei Kyuki, a history book of Miyako, says that it was built around 1720. You can feel a mysterious atmosphere here.
