

Experience Ryukyuan Culture

Utaki is the collective name for sacred sites in Ryukyuan Shinto, and it is here that the kami, or gods, and ancestors are enshrined. Shiokawa-utaki, located in the eastern part of Tarama Island, is one such site, and has been venerated as holy ground since ancient times. A sacred atmosphere surrounds even the happiness trees that line the approach to the utaki.

Learn About Island History

Tarama Island, also known as the "Island of Ancient Writings," is home to many rare historic documents that have not been found even on the main island of Okinawa. Visit the Tarama Village Furusato Folklore Museum and historic sites around the island and explore the history of its ancient people.

Enjoy a Cycling Tour

With a circumference of about 20 km, Tarama Island is the perfect size for a leisurely cycling tour. Visit some tuburi, take a break on a quiet beach, and gaze at goats munching on grass. A relaxed tour while taking in idyllic scenery will ease you into the slow pace of island time.

Get the Most Out of Nature

Diving and snorkeling are some of the most popular ways to experience Tarama Blue. Head out with a local instructor who is an expert on the ocean around Tarama and will point out the unique island geography, creatures, and breathtaking scenery.

Savor Local Dishes

Tarama Village is home to a flourishing trade in goats and cattle, and each family has enjoyed eating goat and beef stews since long ago. Both dishes are known for making the most out of their ingredients for a delicious flavor. Visitors can also try various beverages and handmade sweets crafted with brown sugar.

Main Events on Tarama Island

Hachigatsu Odori Folk Dance

 An Important Intangible Folk-Cultural Asset of Japan This harvest festival is the largest event on Tarama Island, taking place over three days starting on August 8 according to the old calendar.



Sutsuupunaka



This traditional ritual is performed in hopes of a large harvest and prosperity for the island. It is the second largest event after the Hachigatsu Odori folk dance.

Tarama Island Pinda Aasu Fighting Goats



In this event, held annually in May and October, goats in three different classes fight. Goat cuisine is also served.

Marine Day Haari Dragon Boat Race



Villages and companies compete against one another in various haari dragon boat races and events as a way to pray for a bountiful catch of fish and safe ocean voyages.

Tarama Island Marathon



Both tourists and locals run together in this marathon with four events, a 3 km, 5 km, 10 km, and 23.75 km run.



হ Natural Environment

Food and Shopping

It may be difficult to purchase food and beverages depending on the time you arrive on the island and when activities end. If anyone in your party needs special foods, such as baby food, make sure to bring them with you. Some shops and restaurants only accept cash, so it's best to have enough before arriving.



Mobile Phone Service

Mobile phone service may not be available on some parts of the island depending on your carrier or phone. Before arriving on the island, it's best to download map data for offline use and contact your place of lodging ahead of time while a signal is available.
